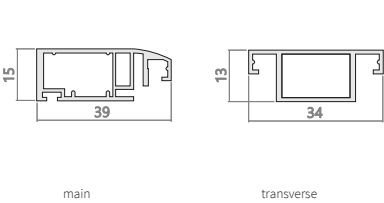

The standard version includes a door system with black or white PVC mesh, fitted with 3 self-closing hinges, 2 magnets or magnetic catches, and a brush seal.

As standard the holes for fitting the handle are at half the height of the screen.

Slight colour differences between profiles are permissible.
So that the screen fits tightly to the door opening, add at least 1 - 2.5 cm of allowance to each side of the opening dimensions.
Determining the allowance is the task of the person measuring or of the person ordering the screen. At maximum dimensions the permissible deflection of a screen door can be up to 1 cm. If the screen exceeds 80 cm in width and 200 cm in height, a transverse profile must be used.
The dispatch option is not available for insect screens.

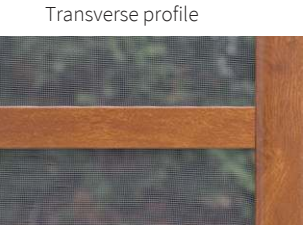
Profiles

Closing type



The transverse profile reinforces the screen construction and is needed to fit the polycarbonate panel.



After fitting the panel of polycarbonate you can open the door easily by pushing with your foot. The panel is available clear or tinted.



The pet door is available in white or brown. Fitting the pet door requires a polycarbonate panel to be installed.



The brush on the handle side is replaced by a magnetic strip, and a steel strip is glued to the window frame (white only). This ensures tighter and stronger closing.

Because of the adhesive properties, this version is not recommended in places heated strongly by the sun.

How to order door systems?

The order must state distance A (absolute width) and distance B (absolute height), and the side on which the mounting clips are fitted (viewed from outside the screen).
